THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE. THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 1.42 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$-9.59 {(Section 26.05(b)1(A&B) OF THE PROPERTY TAX CODE}.

AD VALOREM TAX RATE – **2017:** Consider establishing an ad valorem tax rate for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 by passing on first reading an ordinance establishing the ad valorem tax rate of **\$0.817521** per hundred dollar assessed valuation for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2017 and ending September 30, 2018, and adopting the provisions of Section 31.05 of the State Property Tax Code to provide for discounts under certain conditions.
