**Mandatory Language for Monitoring and Reporting Violation
Failure to Submit a Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report (DLQOR)
MONITORING, ROUTINE (DBP), MAJOR/CHLORINE**

The **CITY OF LAMESA** water system **PWS ID 0580001** has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before disinfection, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfection residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

This violation occurred in the monitoring period: Third quarter of 2014.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

The City of Lamesa performs daily monitoring of the chlorine residual in our water distribution system. All daily residuals for the third quarter of 2014 were performed and logged but we failed to submit the Quarterly Report as required by TCEQ. We will closely monitor this issue to prevent any other re-occurrence by sending the DLQOR reports in a timely manner as required by TCEQ.

Please share this information with all people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (.ie., people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
